**Professor Raman Bedi** was Chief Dental Officer England from October 2002 to October 2005. Professor Bedi was an NHS consultant in Paediatric Dentistry for over 15 years. He specialises in young children with extensive caries and especially those that require full mouth reconstruction under General Anaesthesia. His focus is upon early

childhood caries. Professor Bedi is the paediatric clinical lead for the Harley Street Dental Clinic. He is chair of the charity the Global Child Dental Fund and each year leads an international senior dental leadership programme which is a partnership between King's College London and Harvard University. In the past ten years over 200 senior dentists have trained on the SDL.
